

• Meet the Chefs cooking demonstrations, a show favorite, are returning, too, featuring chefs from the Mount Washington Valley's best restaurants.


• Multi-day ticket: A single-day admission is good for all three days, allowing for repeat visits for food



A big hit last year, cannabis vendors offer new products

FRYEBURG, Maine — With Maine lawmakers expected to allow retail sales of marijuana sometime this year — and towns enacting their own ordinances regarding this fast-moving industry — what more convenient way to learn about it (and check out a wide variety of CBD and cannabisrelated products) than at the Home Garden Flower Show with Cannabis coming May 17-19 to the Fryeburg Fairgrounds?

While possessing small amounts of cannabis for personal use is legal in Maine, retail sales of cannabis is prohibited, although the Legislature is expecting to eventually roll out regs governing what experts say will be a \$250 million industry.

There are two broad categories of cannabis: one with THC (tetrahydrocannabinol), the psychoactive ingredient that gets people high; and CBD (cannabidiol), which is derived from hemp and contains only trace amounts of THC.

CBD is used for medicinal purposes, and the amount of THC in it is so low that CBD products currently are legal in all 50 states.

Most of the cannabis-related exhibitors at the upcoming home and garden show will be selling CBD products.

These products are said to be good for what ails you, and are commonly used to treat joint pain, stress and sleep problems.

Some skeptics dismiss CBD as just another supplement, but the first drug with CBD, Epidiolex, was approved last year by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration to treat a rare and severe forms of epilepsy.

An unfortunate consequence of that approval, however, was that it set off a firestorm in Maine as the FDA then defined CBD as a medicine rather than a supplement and issued a directive banning edible products infused with CBD.

The ban forced Maine's CBD sellers to close down, affecting thousands of growers, processors and retailers. Legislation was quickly passed by the Maine Legislature to effectively overturn the FDA, and Maine Gov. Janet Mills signed a bill last month that put the CBD industry back in business.

The 25 cannabis-related vendors at the show will be selling everything from the products you need to grow your own, plus a variety of CBDinfused items, including oils, creams and edibles. There's even a vendor


Maine Cabin Masters eager to talk with fans of the show

2016. The show reportedly now garners more than 3.5 million viewers.

Answering questions on their website (mainecabinmasters.com), Chase (a k a "The Boss") says that fame has changed his life — a little.

"Before the show started, I would only cut my hair once a year. Usually in early spring, I would shave my head and face, but I only had a set of old dog clippers, so I used those," he said.

"Now I get a haircut and trim the beard every few months. I haven't decided if I will go back to the old routine once the show ends. I still have the clippers."

A 10th-generation Mainer, Chase, along with friends and family, including his sister Ashley and brother-inlaw Ryan, work to renovate classic Maine properties such as lakefront camps and cabins tucked away in the woods.

Chase, 41, who graduated from the College of the Atlantic in Bar Harbor in 2000, is married to Sarah, a registered nurse. They have two children.

Chase's sister Ashley, 44, is married to Ryan, 43. Ashley, who graduated from the University of Maine-Orono, does most of the designing on the cabin makeovers.

Answering the question, "If you could meet one person from history, who would it be?" Ashley replied: "Willie Nelson. I love him. Ryan proposed to me the day after a Willie show. I have reoccurring dreams that

we are BFF's."

Ryan notes his favorite tool to work with is his DeWalt laser. "Every time I use it, I get to do the math at how much money it is saving us. Plus it has a really cool green color."

Interviewed last year on "The Nite Show with Danny Cashman," Bangor's late-night TV talk show, Chase explained how they became "Cabin Masters."

"We grew up with our father, our grandfather, with our family all building, our own house, or other people's camps," he said.

He, Ashley and Ryan all went off to college (Ryan graduated from the University of Maine at Farmington), Chase said. "We all have degrees in different stuff, but we all came back to building."

Things changed when they started doing a timber frame project in Wayne, Maine.

"My daughter's friend's mother works for Kennebec Land Trust, and she knew Dorsey Pictures (a production company based in Denver) and that they were looking for carpenters to do a show with that fixed up old camps," Chase recalled.

"She knew we were carpenters, kind of put us together. We did a couple of Skype interviews, and here we are."

Cashman asked if it was Maine that sold Dorsey on doing the show with them.

"No, it was the beards that sold






Natural fibers for possible medicinal benefits


